Members are invited to present on topics related to how different health systems and policies respond to communicable and non-communicable diseases and related socio-economic considerations in the areas of:

- social and economic impact of neglected tropical diseases;
- social and economic impact of and national responses to malaria, HIV/AIDS, TB and other communicable and non-communicable diseases;
- economic and policy considerations with regard to vaccine preventable diseases;
- the burden of communicable and non-communicable diseases.
